## Your Child's Good Dental Health is in Your Hands

- Nearly **1 in 4 children have cavities before they start school**. So it's important to get them into the dentist as soon as their first tooth appears, usually around 6 months of age. And as the children age, ask for **sealants** which can protect their back teeth.
- Use fluoride, but not too much: Most municipal water is fluorinated. If yours is not, consider having your children rinse with fluoride after they brush. It will go a long way to preventing cavities. When they brush, don't overdue the toothpaste. Just a pea sized portion is enough for kids.
- Brush and floss daily – One of the easiest things to do to protect your teeth is to brush twice a day for two minutes and floss daily. Not sure how long 2 minutes is? Search the web for apps and videos to engage kids while they brush. And replace that toothbrush 3-4 times a year. That will keep the bacteria out of your mouth.
- Eat smart – We all know that sugary treats and soda can be bad for the waistline, but they can also do serious damage to the enamel on your teeth. The best bet is to keep these foods to a minimum. But when you do, brush or at least rinse your mouth with water after.
- Make an appointment. Most experts recommend a dental check-up every 6 months. That way not only can you get plaque buildup removed, but your exam could help detect more serious issues such as tooth grinding, gum disease and oral cancer.
